Workshop programme in progress

On behalf of the Programme Committee for the 10th. European Union of Supported Employment Conference in Copenhagen, Denmark on June 15th-16th we are pleased to let you know, that the conference workshops now have been chosen and the 24 abstract holders have been informed. Now we just need the final confirmation and then the full programme of workshops will be available on www.euse2011.org

As we hope to have the program ready in the start of April, please follow the development on the website carefully. You will soon be able to choose the three workshops you would like to attend. As you all know there will always be possible changes in the programme due to cancellation. Because of that you will be asked to choose a first priority and a second priority in each round of workshops. At the same time you will be asked to choose between the three parallel sessions.

Duran Duran at Tivoli Garden

We are very happy to announce that Tuesday June 14th the day of the pre-conference and just after the reception at the Town Hall the British pop band Duran Duran will perform live at a concert in Tivoli Gardens just next to Town Hall. We have been able to get tickets for this event at a reduced price for participants in the 10th. EUSE Conference and "hang-arounds".

Tickets for this once in a lifetime-event will be sold at the EUSE Conference check-in desk at the Marriott Hotel on April 14th. And you will also be able to purchase these tickets at the reception at the Town Hall. The price will be 90 DKK / 12 EUR and will beside the concert include admission to Tivoli Gardens. The normal admission to Tivoli is 120 DKK / 16 EUR.

Sustainable conference

The Local Organising Committee of the 10th EUSE Conference in Copenhagen has decided that the conference will be held in the spirit of sustainability.

This will amongst other things mean that we will try to reduce the amount of paper printouts, and the amount of unnecessary one-time conference material such as commercial bags and tourist material also available at hotels and tourist information offices. We will where possible use fairtrade and socio economic companies as our suppliers and partners.

In the selection of conference material we will emphasize using sustainable and fair trade materials and creating sustainable solutions in stead of one-time solutions.

Some of the visible initiatives of this policy you as a conference participant will experience are: Making lists of conference participants and abstracts available on the website www.euse2011.org instead of printing handouts. Using water in pitches instead of bottled water at the conference venue. Reducing printed out conference material to a minimum and instead provide live service when needed.

Private housing.

As you all know the expenses of staying at hotels in Denmark is as huge as the Danish scores in surveys of “happiness amongst inhabitants” all over the world. In recognition of these huge expenses being hard to cover for some people, we are now happy to offer a number of participants the possibility of Private Housing in Copenhagen during their stay at the 10th EUSE Conference. However you should notice that this offer is only for a limited number of persons.
